From Our Pastor

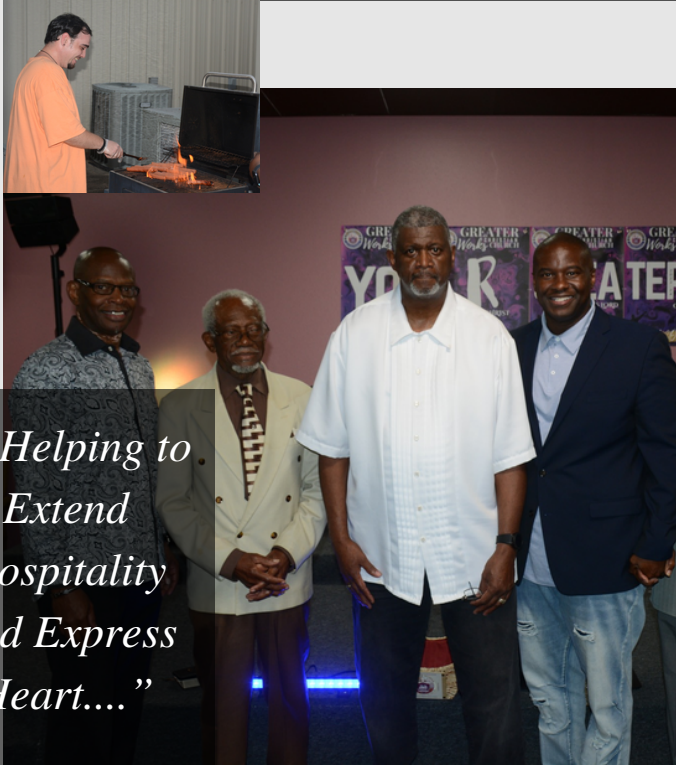

MARSHALL TRAYLOR

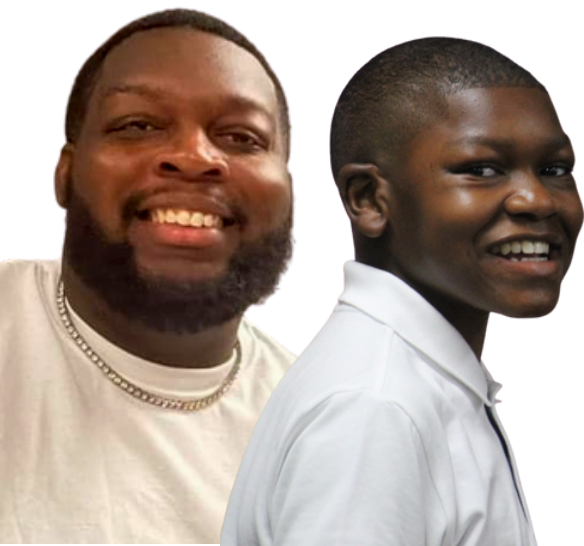

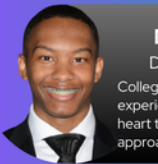
